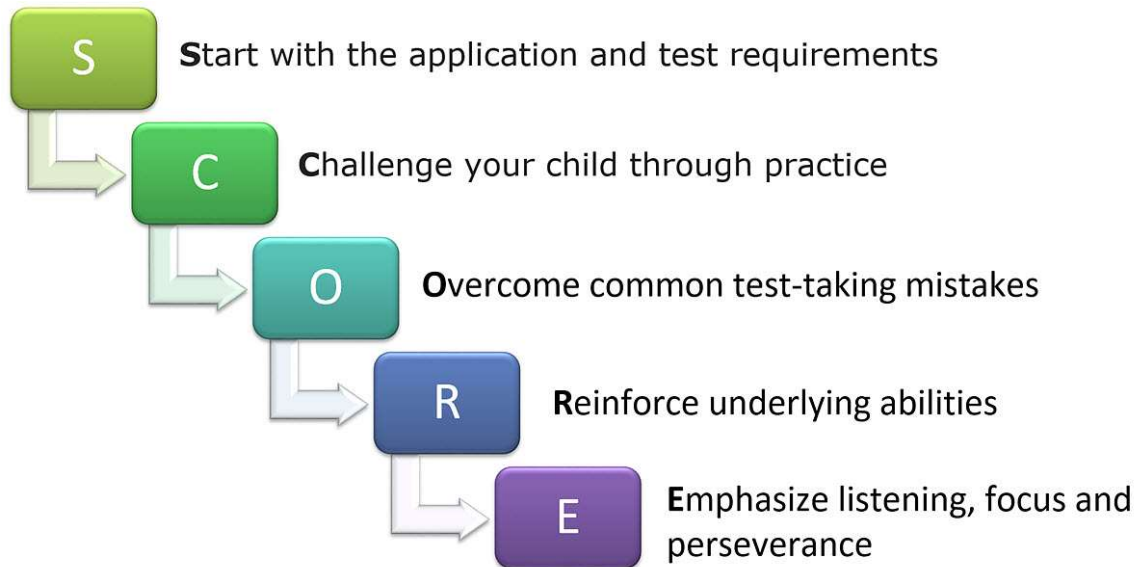


S.C.O.R.E. SYSTEM – STEP 4



Reinforce underlying abilities

1. How do you know if the problem is lack of underlying ability or something else?
2. Look at each subtest and ask yourself, “What underlying abilities does my child need to answer this type of question?”
3. When you have isolated what your child needs to know/do, then come up with fun, creative ways to work on these abilities outside of test practice.

4. For highly conceptual questions on a test, you may have to bring it down to “real life” for your child first.
